Social Skills Group Descriptions

3-5 year olds

Focus is on building pre-school/kindergarten skills

- sitting and attending to activities
- following directions
- circle time (calendar, weather, seasons)
- turn taking/games/play skills
- familiarizing children with pre-school songs/nursery rhymes

6-9 year olds

Focus is on building positive social skills for home, school, and in the community

- listening/following directions
- positive social behavior (voice volume control, play skills, friendship making skills)
- coping skills
- feelings identification

10-12 year olds

Focus is on building positive social skills for home, school, and in the community

- Non-verbal communication/reading social cues
- feelings identification
- coping skills
- problem solving

13-17 year olds

Focus is on building positive social relationships and looking towards the future

- friendship skills
- coping skills
- interest inventory/future planning for transition from school to work or higher education
